Head Injuries

Anyone who receives a head injury should be observed for 24 to 48 hours.

During the first 8 to 12 hours after the injury, check your child for the following behaviors:

1. Ability to awaken.
2. Ability to talk understandably.
3. Ability to walk or use arms and legs normally.

Watch for signs of the following symptoms:

1. Persistent severe headaches.
2. Persistent vomiting.
3. Bleeding from ears or nose.
4. Seizures or convulsions.
